Dangerous Dumping from Windows!

We continue to receive reports that some residents are dropping items from their windows and balconies in their multi-storey flats. Anyone found to be involved with dropping or throwing items will be reported to the Police for the serious crime of Culpable & Reckless Conduct.

Some recent reports include scrap food, bread, tea bags, soiled nappies, soiled pet bags, cigarette ends and even a television being dropped from several floors up. This behaviour is criminal, totally unacceptable and could severely injure or even kill someone.

West Dunbartonshire Bulk Refuse Disposal

West Dunbartonshire Council has confirmed to Cube that from 1 January 2010, a charge of £15 will be made to the homeowner, occupier or landlord requesting the Special Uplift service. There are to be no exceptions to the charge and payment in advance of uplift is a requirement.

The existing minimum charge of £42.00 for the removal of waste arising from works of home improvement, repair or alteration will remain in place.

As an alternative to paying the charge, householders may take their bulky waste to the Council's Household Waste Recycling Centres at Dalmoak, Renton or Ferry Road, Old Kilpatrick.
